The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is effective as of 02/12/2021 to establish an affiliation by and between

Ranaghat College, a Government Sponsored Degree College under the Department of Higher Education, Government of West Bengal with its office at Old Berhampore Road, Ranaghat, West Bengal-742101 established in 1950 affiliated to University of Kalyani, hereinafter referred to as Ranaghat College and represented by its principal, referred to as FIRST PARTY,

AND

Berhampore College, Berhampore a West Bengal Government Aided undergraduate degree College with its office at 20, C.R. Das Road, Berhampore, Murshidabad, West Bengal-742101 established in 1963 affiliated to University of Kalyani, hereinafter referred to as Berhampore College and represented by its Principal, referred to as SECOND PARTY,

The aforesaid institutions are hereinafter referred to individually/ collectively as college/ colleges

PREAMBLE

Whereas, Ranaghat College and Berhampore College have many areas of common interest in Arts, Commerce and Science, considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit of academic excellence and holistic development on a collaborative basis in the fields of academics, pedagogy, and research. Now therefore, Ranaghat College and Berhampore College have decided to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU), which defines the framework for the cooperation of the two institutions in the following sections.

ARTICLE 1: PURPOSE OF THE AGREEMENT

This Memorandum is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration. Both colleges agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, based on equality and reciprocity.

The two institutions shall seek to promote:


A. Faculty/ Staff exchanges

- Each institution will promote the exchange of faculty for the common US Honours, a) Programme, Major & Minor Courses.
- b) Faculty exchange for the mutual benefit of both restitutions.
- c) Collaboration in teaching, research and development, and consultancy studies in the field of mutual interest.
- d) Exchange of academic materials and publications
- e) Undertaking joint research projects wherever feasible
- Participating in seminars, workshops, symposium, other kinds of academic discussions, f)
- Conducting study tours and joint consultancy vork wherever feasible g)
- Each Teacher will be responsible for their own transportation and daily allowances to and from the host institution.
- Exchange of non-teaching staff on proper need-based situations for assistar ce/skill or knowledge development in areas pertaining to their areas of work, with allowances as agreed upon by the Coordination Committee.
- A specific plan will be worked out for each activity and detailed arrangements for such collaborative work will be agreed upon.

B. Student Exchange

- a) Students in the exchange programme will be selected by mutual agreement between the home and the host college in the field of curricular and co-curricular activities.
- b) Students in an exchange programme may be evaluated by the host institution if such an evaluative framework for the academic interest of students be worked out; this will in no way impade or influence her/ his evaluation in home college or university assessment/ evaluation.

C. Other areas

- To exchange information on research and educational programmes
- b) To exchange information on teaching, learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programmes.
- c) To jointly organize seminars, faculty development programmes, workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein.
- d) To explore the provision of cultural and intellectual enrichment opportunities for staff, faculty and students of both institutes.
- To use library reading room facilities for a specified period.
- To use laboratory facilities in specific cases (with prior approval of Principal) for a limited period.

Ranaghat College and Berhampore College agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be determined separately and agreed upon by the two colleges. These terms will include a technical description of the proposed activity, financial arrangements and person(s) responsible for its implementation.

ARTICLE 2: COORDINATION

Each college shall appoint one member of its teaching faculty to coordinate the programme on behalf of the principal of each college further, a Coordination Committee consisting of two Principals and the two Coordinators will periodically (once or twice a year) review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between two colleges.

ARTICLE 3: CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

The two colleges will retain and respect individual confidentiality, including those pertaining to the collaborative activities of both colleges.

ARTICLE 4: INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

Ownership of any intellectual property (including but not limited to confidential information, know-how, patents, copyrights, design rights, rights relating to computer software and any other industrial or intellectual property rights) developed jointly during the course of this MoU shall be vested in both the colleges in this MoU. Both the colleges shall have right to determine the commercial implications, disposition and exploitation of such intellectual property and shall make joint applications for the registration of the same. Any publication regarding such intellectual property shall be possible with prior written consent of both colleges.

ARTICLE 5: VALIDITY

Initially, the MoU shall remain in force for a period of Five years commencing from the effective date. Institutions may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after review.

ARTICLE 6: TERMINATION

Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice of One month in advance to the other institution.

Nothing in this MoU shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the two colleges. This Memorandum is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.

ARTICLE 8: DISPUTE RESOLUTION

In case of a dispute relating to any aspect of academic cooperation, Principals of both colleges will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect and shared responsibility.

Ranaghat College and Berhampore College welcome the establishment of this Memorandum for cooperation and jointly agree to the provisions set out above.
