Evaluating the above information,IQAC observed that students' enrollment in current academic session has increased (almost 8%) compared to that in last academic session 2018-19. Number of full time teacher increased as a result of implementation the policy of West Bengal Government to permanent the guest teacher as State Aided College Teacher(memo no:......). Aftermath of this rise in full time faculty mentor mentee ratio improved significantly in academic session 2019-20. However Student's enrolment profile of Berhampore College of the academic session 2019-20 showed a declining trend compared to its previous academic session i.e.; 2018-19. Detailed analysis of the data revealed that number of enrolled students in 1st year UG level has increased from 2560 to 2764 during academic session2018-19 to 2019-20. But an advanced study revealed that students who ever enrolled in 1st year UG level in 2018-19 were not currently completing their education. This was the reason for sharp reduction in enrolment into 2nd and 3rd year undergraduate level especially in general category in the year 2019-20. The might happened for the following reasons:

- 1. Male students compelled to engage in economic activities at the early stage due to the district's poor economic condition. Lack of financial assistance from their family, they were not able to continue their higher education.
- 2. The same financial harshness was the main reasons behind the termination of female students from their course of learning before to complete. They have to incur heavy burden of domestic chores, rearing siblings, care of older people of the family, etc. in the household due to poor financial status of family.
- 3. In addition, cultural tradition of the adjacent community believes that female should have that level of learning which is beneficial of getting "groom'from market of marriage. So members of family are unwilling to allow their girls for further education rather to search a groom for them. Students can get financial assistance (especially female students in form of Kanyashree) at their entry level. So they are eager to enrol but do not willing to continue their studies
- 4. The financially poor students have diverted to the distance learning education due to their inability to join regular class schedule, lengthy syllabus, as well as higher expenditure of the course.
- 5. Poor job employability of the economy is another major reason behind the declining trend of enrolment in higher study.

- 7. In particular in our college, discontinuation of NCC wing may exert negative impact on enrolment.
- 8. A meticulous analysis has revealed that continuous declining trend was acute in general category level of education and linguist subject. We thing lack of job opportunities may be cause behind such trend.
