Compliance Report of Berhampore College regarding Anti Ragging

1. College has formed Anti-Ragging Committee since 2017 and formed Anti-Ragging Squad on 22.07.2026.
2. The College has publicly displayed information against ragging and provided contact numbers for reporting or seeking help, both across the campus and on its official website, so that everyone is aware of the anti-ragging rules and support available.
3. College organizes regular sessions to educate students and their parents about ragging, its harmful effects, the rules prohibiting it, and the procedures for reporting incidents. These programmes help create awareness, promote a safe and respectful campus environment, and encourage everyone to prevent and report ragging.
4. College has taken initiative to collect undertaking about anti ragging from both students and parents. To make the process convenient, the college has published the submission link on its official website so that the undertaking can be accessed and completed easily.
5. The college maintains regular monitoring and supervision of classrooms, common rooms, hostels, corridors, canteens, entrances, and other vulnerable locations to prevent ragging and ensure a safe learning environment. Faculty members, hostel wardens, administrative staff, and members of the Anti-Ragging Committee conduct periodic inspections and maintain vigilance, particularly during the beginning of the academic session. This continuous monitoring helps deter ragging, enables the timely identification of any incidents, and ensures prompt intervention whenever necessary.
6. The college regularly convenes meetings of the Anti-Ragging Committee to review the implementation and effectiveness of anti-ragging measures on campus. During these meetings, the committee assesses preventive strategies, discusses any complaints or concerns, evaluates awareness initiatives, and plans further actions to strengthen the anti-ragging framework. The committee also reviews compliance with applicable regulations, monitors the functioning of Anti ragging mechanisms, and recommends measures to ensure a safe, secure, and ragging-free environment for all students.
7. The college has established a well-defined complaint mechanism to enable students to report incidents of ragging or related grievances safely, promptly, and, where appropriate, confidentially.

Information about the complaint procedure, contact details of the Anti-Ragging Committee, Anti-Ragging Squad, and relevant helpline numbers has been prominently displayed at key locations across the campus. These measures ensure that students are aware of the available support systems and can easily seek assistance or report concerns, contributing to a safe, responsive, and ragging-free campus environment.

8. The college has published comprehensive information about the Anti-Ragging Committee and student helpline numbers on its official website to ensure easy access for students, parents, and other stakeholders. The website provides details of the committee members, their roles and responsibilities, contact information, and the procedure for reporting ragging-related incidents. It also displays the student helpline numbers and other relevant support services, enabling students to seek assistance or lodge complaints promptly. By making this information readily available online, the college promotes transparency, awareness, and accessibility while reinforcing its commitment to maintaining a safe, inclusive, and ragging-free campus environment.

9. The college maintains a systematic record of all ragging-related complaints and the actions taken to address them. Every complaint received is promptly examined by the Anti-Ragging Committee and other designated authorities, following the prescribed procedures to ensure a fair and timely inquiry. Appropriate disciplinary and corrective measures are taken wherever necessary, in accordance with institutional rules and applicable regulations. The status of each case is monitored until it is resolved, ensuring transparency, accountability, and the effective implementation of the college's zero-tolerance policy towards ragging. At present, all reported ragging incidents have been addressed and resolved in accordance with the established procedures.

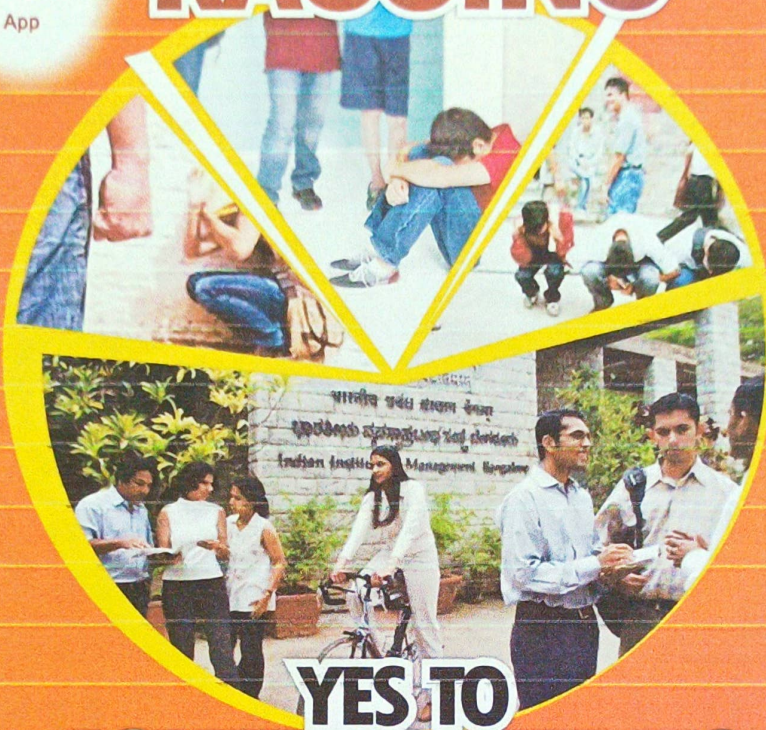

Any Act Resulting in:

- Criminal Intimidation/wrongful Restraint
- Undermining Human Dignity
- Financial Exploitation/extortion
- Use Of Force

A STUDENT INDULGING IN RAGGING CAN BE:

- Cancellation of admission.
- Suspension from attending classes.
- Withholding/withdrawing Scholarship/Fellowship and other benefits.
- Debarring from appearing in any test/ examination or other evaluation process.
- Withholding results.
- Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament or youth festival etc.
- **Collective punishment** : when the persons committing or abetting the crime of ragging are not identified the institution shall resort to collective punishment as a deterrent to ensure community pressure on potential ragger.

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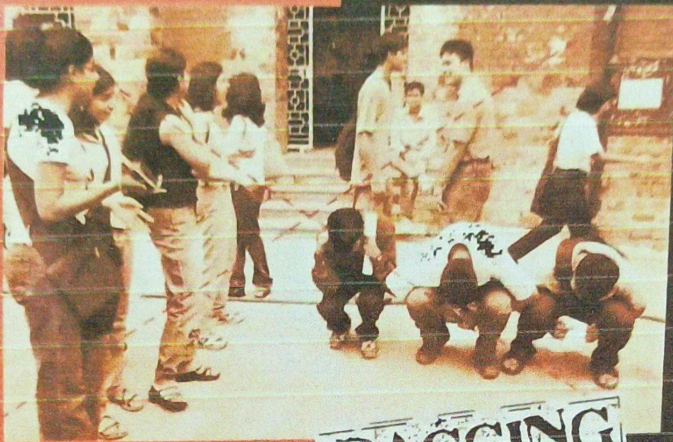

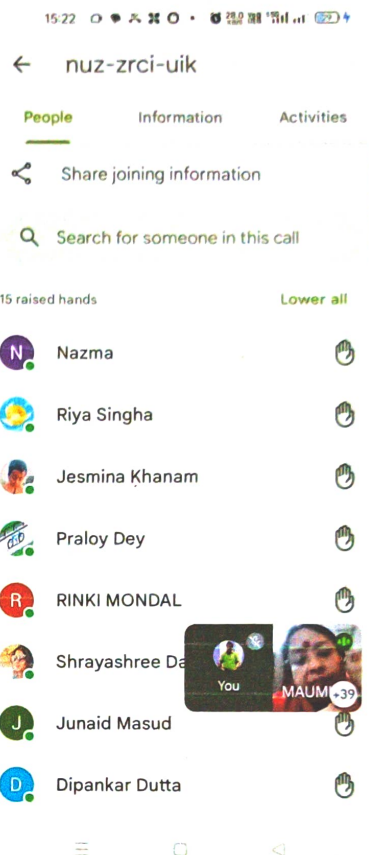
